Can you shoot through mesh on Ameristep ground blinds?

Yes. The mesh is shoot-through, but only with a fixed blade broadhead.
What is the warranty on an Ameristep ground blind?

Ameristep ground blinds come with a 1-year manufacturer's warranty. However, this warranty does not cover any type of animal or weather damage that may occur.

What are the loops on the top of my blind for?

Many Ameristep ground blinds feature brush loops, intended to hold natural foliage. By adding items like brush, leaves and branches, you can better conceal your blind to truly disappear into nature.

What is the best way to open my ground blind?

Setup and takedown may vary from model to model. For our hub blinds, we recommend starting with the roof hub first, then the four wall hubs when opening. Do this in reverse when collapsing the blind: first pushing in the four wall hubs then the roof hub.

What is the weight capacity of the tree steps?

Ameristep offers two tree step models. The Step-Up Tree Step will hold up to 750 pounds. The Grizzly Tree Step has even more load-bearing power with a maximum weight of 1,250 pounds.
