
Measuring your dog to fit the DOOG harness:

- 1. Measure the circumference of the thickest part of the neck
- 2. Measure the **girth** of your dog's body, behind his front legs Add 1 inch or 3cms to each measurement so your dog has room to move in the harness.

Your dog should be able to step into the harness and the harness will clip up at the top of his back. It should be a tight fit but you should be able to slip 2 fingers under it comfortably so not too tight!
